

SISP: demonstration in front of the Conseil du trésor

On December 13 last, the member organizations of the *Secrétariat intersyndical des services publics* (SISP) took part in a demonstration, in front of the office of the *Conseil du trésor* in Quebec City, to denounce once again Bill 142 and the antidemocratic bills passed under closure. Two years after the imposition of a bill decreeing the working conditions and salaries for public service employees, workers continue to demand that their rights be respected.

On December 12, the FIQ presented a brief before the Bouchard-Taylor Commission on accommodation practices related to cultural differences. On the basis of the results of a questionnaire sent to members, the Federation's opinion paper focused on the issue of demands of a religious nature in public space, and in particular in the health and social services, rather than on the question of reasonable accommodations. Despite the sense of urgency that appeared in the media coverage, demands of a religious nature do not appear to be a major problem; rather, they are well integrated in the daily activities of care professionals.
