SLAPP: presentation of an opinion by the SISP

Strategic lawsuits against public participation, commonly known as SLAPPs are a real threat to democracy since they create a imbalance. To highlight the urgency of government action on this issue, the SISP sent an opinion on February 1 to the Quebec commission on SLAPPs, the Commission des institutions sur les poursuites stratégiques contre la mobilisation publique. The government must intervene to protect freedom of opinion and expression, the right of petition and access to justice.
