



## **Regional Consensus-building and Action Table for Montreal**

On April 1, in Montreal, local and regional unions affiliated to the Federation launched the Regional Consensus-building and Action Table (RCAT). Essentially designed to be a regional structure for mobilisation, education and action, this Table will enable the unions in the region to exchange on the various issues that concern care professionals. Given the current political context, it has become essential to mobilise, develop regional solidarity, promote exchange of information and develop public awareness of the various problems in the health-care network.

Such consensus-building and action tables have already been set up in the Eastern Townships, Saguenay-Lac-Saint-Jean, Montérégie and Lanaudière.
