

The Interunion coalition on mental health asks that Minister Couillard take action


Almost one year after having sounded the alarm about the risks related to the lack of planning in view of the reorganization of mental health services on the Montreal territory, union organizations observe that the Health and Social Services agency has not been able to coordinate the transfers of clientele and human resources presented in the ministerial action plan.


The waiting lists are growing longer and the consequences of the shortage of specialized personnel are constantly getting worse. Several CSSSs that were supposed to receive patients until now treated in psychiatric hospital centres will have difficulty shouldering their new responsibilities.

With the coming of Mental Health Week, unions announced that they would coordinate in order to negotiate, for each institution concerned, a transfer protocol in view of reducing the impact of the reform on the affected clientele. Nevertheless, ministerial intervention is essential in order for the negotiations to make progress.
