



Quebec Health Record: implicit consent and smart cards on the menu

On April 29, the FIQ tabled a brief at the Social Affairs Committee within the context of the study of Bill 70, An Act to amend the Act respecting health services and social services, the Health Insurance Act and the Act respecting the Régie de l'assurance maladie du Québec. The FIQ wanted to use these parliamentary committee hearings as an opportunity to make observations on the content of Bill 70, based on the orientations and positions it has adopted concerning the implementation of the Quebec Health Record. The FIQ calls for the repatriation of Omar Khadr

The FIQ has added its voice to those of various groups supporting the Bloc Québécois petition calling on the Government of Canada to repatriate Omar Khadr so that he can be judged in his own country by his peers. The treatment reserved for this Canadian citizen, arrested at age 15 and imprisoned since 2002 at Guantanamo, a prison camp at the U.S. naval base in Cuba, is unjust and contravenes the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child, which Canada has signed.
