The FIQ held a press conference on April 7 in order to publicly state its concerns about an upgrade in nurses initial training.

The Federation has made the choice in this file to play its union role and to stand up in defence of its members in order to insure that their rights are protected and that their expertise and their experience are recognized.

Faced with the firm commitment of the majority of the stakeholders sitting on the interministerial-partners committee, headed by the OIIQ, to make the Bachelor of Nursing the entrance standard to access the nursing profession, the president, Régine Laurent, accompanied by Roberto Bomba, Treasurer of the FIQ, wanted to present the other side of the coin by explaining the context, the issues and the impacts linked to this major transformation.
