They denounced the abnormal management of the institution and protested against the deteriorating working climate and conditions. The

institution's administration responded the same day by way of a news release, indicating that they would be reviewing the disciplinary measures taken and announcing that the head of human resources, in the position since November 2012, would be leaving. A small victory! To be followed...
