In order to get away from the ceremonial discussions and allow for an exchange of ideas, this year the FIQ proposed an "open forum", inspired by the social forums where the topics are proposed by the participants and where the right to speak is

given to everyone. This formula gave the delegates the chance to address, in the form of

workshops, more than thirty topics such as the political role of the FIQ, prostitution, working conditions of pregnant women, the use of the internet for mobilization, the place of licensed practical nurses and the respiratory therapists, nurse-patient ratios. Stenographers transcribed the discussions and the summaries will be available in the coming weeks and will be put on FIQ en direct – militantes.
