The healthcare professionals won't be silenced

As part of a press conference held on February 6, the president of the FIQ, Régine Laurent, and the vice-president, Line Larocque, reacted to the Québec Government's decision to suspend the National Assembly rules to force the passing of Bill 10, thus silencing the democratic debate. "There is nothing in this Bill for the patients or for the healthcare professionals. It is a sad day for our health network and for democracy in Québec", stated the president, also adding that "the healthcare professionals won't be silenced, we will continue to fight for safe, quality care".



A great victory for the CSSS des Pays-d'en-Haut

Thanks to the perseverance of the union representatives from the *Syndicat des professionnelles* en soins des Pays-d'en-Haut and the FIQ union consultant, the assistants to the immediate superior (AIS), at the *Centre d'hébergement des Hauteurs*, will at last be given fair compensation for the shift overlap period, as stipulated in the collective agreement. Indeed, the employer admitted being wrong when he applied the overlap period on 35 hours, because in this CHSLD, which operates 24 hours a day and 7 days a week, the workweek is 36.25 hours. The settlement represents more than \$60,000 divided between 14 AISs. The amounts due were paid just before the holiday period. A great victory!
