In a press release on May 25, the FIQ welcomed Bill 691 that was tabled in the National Assembly by the *Parti Québécois* MNA, Diane Lamarre positively. "Governing and creating guidelines for the incidental expenses in health care is exacerbating the privatization of the health network. These expenses are another way for the physicians to increase their income by directly dipping into the pockets of the patients. The incidental expenses are unacceptable and must be forbidden", stated the president of the FIQ, Régine Laurent.
